



## HALL OF FAME INDUCTION POLICY

### 1. Purpose

To recognise and honour members who have made an exceptional contribution to the club and the sport through outstanding football achievements.

### 2. Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for induction, nominees must:

#### i. Football Career

- Have played or held an official position for Tuggeranong United Football Club or its predecessors as described in the club's constitution; and
- have attained noteworthy achievements as a player, coach, referee or team support role. This may include;
  - Represented Australia at senior level
  - Represented another country at senior level
  - Outstanding footballing success for TUFC
  - Outstanding footballing success at national league level
  - Sustained and dedicated service to TUFC
  - Outstanding contribution to and influence on Tuggeranong United's football growth

#### ii. Retirement Requirement

- Will typically be retired from senior competitive football for a minimum of 3 years  
(Exceptions may apply at the discretion of the selection committee)

### 3. Selection Criteria

Nominees will be judged on,

- Influence of their contribution on the history of TUFC
- Excellence of performance in their field
- Representative honours
- Exemplification of TUFC's values and loyalty

#### **4. Nomination Process**

- Nominations may be submitted by:
  - Club members
  - Coaches or former players
  - The Hall of Fame Subcommittee
- Each nomination must include:
  - A detailed playing history
  - Supporting achievements and statistics
  - A written statement outlining the nominee's impact

#### **5. Selection Process**

- A Hall of Fame Selection Committee will be appointed by the TUFC Management Board, and will assess all nominations annually
- The committee will consist of:
  - 1 current Board member
  - Up to 3 former players or club legends
  - 1 independent community member with sporting background
- Inductees must be approved by a majority vote
- Inductees will be limited to 10 individuals in the first year of establishment, six in the second and third years, and three each year after that.
- The selection committee will take into account aspiring to a balanced representation within the Hall of Fame of gender and time periods.

#### **6. Recognition**

Inductees will:

- Be honoured at an annual presentation or gala event
- Receive a commemorative plaque or certificate
- Be permanently recognised on the Hall of Fame Honour lists

#### **7. Revocation of Induction**

- The Club reserves the right to revoke an individual's induction into the Hall of Fame if, in the opinion of the TUFC Management Board, the individual:
  - Has been convicted of a serious criminal offence
  - Has engaged in conduct unbecoming or prejudicial to the interests or reputation of the Club
  - Has breached the Club's Code of Conduct or brought the Hall of Fame into disrepute
- The individual will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity to respond before a final decision is made.
