REGISTRATION PAYMENT POLICY

Introduction

Tuggeranong United Football Club (TUFC) recognises that playing football can place a strain on family budgets and paying the full cost of player registration fees up front is not always affordable. In an effort to reduce the impact registration fees have on family budgets, TUFC has a number of payment options available.

TUFC understands these pressures, however, the Club incurs a number of expenses based on registrations, e.g. equipment, field hire, playing & training kit, insurance, and affiliation fees. As such, the club has a responsibility to manage finances for the benefit of all members as well as allowing it to adequately deliver programs it has committed to run.

2. Payment Options

If registration fees are not paid through Play Football, they will be paid through TUFC's 360Player platform. All players and parents/guardians of under 18 yo players are required to be registered on 360Player. It is the platform the Club uses to communicate with members and for teams to manage their activities and communications.

You will be provided a registration payment link of which two payment options are available.

1. Full payment; or
2. Payment Plan (fortnightly).

Payment Plans Terms and Conditions.

1. It is the player's and/or guardian's responsibility to ensure agreed payment plans are adhered to.
2. All registration fees must be paid in full by the 26th of June in the year that the registration is due.
3. If you are going to miss a payment please contact the Club's Treasurer (Treasurer@tufc.org.au) in advance so that arrangements can be made.
4. TUFC acknowledges that circumstances change and encourages players and/or guardians affected to contact the Treasurer and agree on a mutually beneficial outcome as soon as possible.
5. TUFC reserves the right to charge an administration fee, equivalent to 10% of the balance owing, for missed payments.
6. If all fees owing have not been paid in full by COB on the 26th of June of the same year, TUFC will cancel the player's registration with TUFC and Capital Football. Further to this, TUFC will be forced to hold the player's registration, TUFC will notify Capital Football thus preventing registration with other clubs until all outstanding fees are paid in full.
7. Unfinancial players, as of 26th June, will not be allowed to play or participate in training.

Note:

TUFC offers players the opportunity to secure Player Sponsorship. These sponsorships provide businesses with a range of benefits. They are available for 100% of playing fees with an amount added to help support-club-wide activities.
